SOP FOR NASYA

- > Temperature is checked by infrared gun
- Patient's hands are sanitized.
- > Whole procedure is explained to the patient
- Therapy table sanitization is done.
- > Patient is given supine position
- Person doing the procedure sanitizes hands.
- > Snehan massage with til oil is done over forehead, nose and face is done for 10 minutes
- > Swedan steam fomentation is done over face for 10 minutes
- Head is tilted at 45°
- > 6 drops of medicine (Anu tel etc.) are instilled in each nostril
- > Patient is asked to breath in and out
- > After spitting out secretions the patient is asked to gargle with warm water
- > Patient is informed to avoid exposure of cold air or water to the face after nasya for 2 hours
- > The therapy table is sanitized

SOP FOR TARPAN

- > Temperature is checked by infrared gun
- > Patient's hands are sanitized.
- > Whole procedure is explained to the patient
- > Therapy table sanitization is done.
- > Patient is given supine position
- Person doing the procedure sanitizes hands.
- Snehan massage with til oil is done over forehead, nose and face is done for 5 minutes
- Swedan steam fomentation is done over face for 5 minutes
- Head is tilted at 45°
- > 4 drops of medicine (Anu tel etc.) are instilled in each nostril
- > Patient is asked to breath in and out
- > After spitting out secretions the patient is asked to gargle with warm water
- > Swimming goggles (with hole in the glass) are fitted over the eyes
- > Melted medicated warm ghee is poured in the eyes
- > Patient is asked to blink and blinks are counted.

- > After completion of expected blink count, medicated ghee is removed from gogle with the help of syringe.
- > Eyes are cleaned with warm water
- > Therapy table is sanitized again

SOP FOR ANJAN

- > Temperature is checked by infrared gun
- > Patient's hands are sanitized.
- > Complete procedure is explained to the patient
- > Therapy table sanitization is done.
- > Patient is given supine position
- > Person doing the procedure sanitizes hands.
- > One eye of patient is opened with one hand and patient is asked to look up
- > The drug used for anjana is applied in the lower fornix with the help of shalaka.
- > Patient is asked to close the eye and move the eye.
- > Excess lacrimation is wiped off with cotton.
- > Whole procedure is repeated on other eye if necessary
- > Patient is asked to stay in supine position till the burning or irritation caused by anjan is subsided.
- > Therapy table sanitization is done again.

SOP FOR BIDALAK

- > Temperature is checked by infrared gun
- > Patient's hands are sanitized.
- > Complete procedure is explained to the patient
- > Therapy table sanitization is done.
- > Patient is given supine position
- > Patient is asked to close both eyes
- Person doing the procedure sanitizes hands.
- > Drug for bidalak is mixed with water and paste is made
- > Medicine paste is applied over the lids of the affected eye. Lid margin is excluded from the application.
- > Bidalak is kept for 10 minutes and it is not let to dry
- > Paste is wiped off with the use of moist gauze piece.
- > Therapy table sanitization is done again.

SOP FOR PARISHEK

- > Temperature is checked by infrared gun
- > Patient's hands are sanitized.
- > Complete procedure is explained to the patient
- > Therapy table sanitization is done.
- > Patient is given supine position
- > Patient is asked to close both eyes
- > Person doing the procedure sanitizes hands.
- > Liquid used for parishek is poured on the lids with a continuous thin stream
- > The liquid is collected in a container kept near outer canthus
- > Eyes are cleaned with cotton
- > Therapy table sanitization is done again.

SOP FOR PARISHEK

- > Temperature is checked by infrared gun
- > Patient's hands are sanitized.
- > Complete procedure is explained to the patient
- > Therapy table sanitization is done.
- > Patient is given supine position
- > Patient is asked to close both eyes
- > Person doing the procedure sanitizes hands.
- > Bolus of crushed medicine is kept over the eyes for 15 minutes
- > Medicine is removed after 15 minutes
- > Eyes are cleaned with cotton
- > Therapy table sanitization is done again.

SOP FOR KARNAPURAN

- > Temperature is checked by infrared gun
- > Patient's hands are sanitized.
- > Whole procedure is explained to the patient
- > Therapy table sanitization is done.
- > Patient is given lateral position (opposite to the affected ear)
- > Person doing the procedure sanitizes hands.
- > Ear is massaged with warm til oil for 5 minutes followed by fomentation for 5 minutes

- Warm medicated oil is poured in the affected ear and is kept for definite time (varies according to the disease).
- > Patient is asked to take supine position and the medicated oil is removed from ear
- > Cotton swab is kept in ear for 1 hour
- > Therapy table sanitization is done again.

SOP FOR KARNADHUPAN

- > Temperature is checked by infrared gun
- > Patient's hands are sanitized.
- > Whole procedure is explained to the patient
- > Therapy table sanitization is done.
- > Patient is given sitting position
- > Person doing the procedure sanitizes hands.
- > Ear toileting is done
- > Medicated smoke is made to enter the ear intermittently for 10 minutes
- > Ear cleaning is done again.
- > Therapy table sanitization is done again.
