Sir/Madam,

With reference to the subject mentioned above, I am directed to inform you that in pursuance of the provision of National commission for Indian System of Medicine Act, 2020, the Indian Medicine Central Council Act,1970 (48 of 1970) has been repealed with effect from the 11th day of June, 2021. With effect from the said date, the Central Council of Indian Medicine constituted under sub-division (1) of section 3 of the Indian Medicine Central Council Act, 1970 (48 of 1970) shall stand dissolved. Now, in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (3) of the section 1 of the said Act, the Central Government hereby notifies that all the provisions of the National Commission for Indian System of Medicine Act, 2020 has been come into force with effect from the 11th day of June, 2021 and as per regulation 59 (2) of The National Commission for Indian System of Medicine ACT, 2020, Medical standards, requirements and other provisions of the Indian Medicine Central Council Act, 1970 and the rules and regulations made thereunder shall continue to be in force and operate till new standards or requirements are specified under this Act or the rules and regulations made thereunder. Further, the provision of concerned regulations which are inconsistent with the provision of NCISM ACT 2020 shall not be applicable.

- I am to refer to your application vide ref. no. YMTA/861/2022 dated 16.11.2022, on the subject cited above and to verify the available facilities of teaching, non-teaching, hospital staff and other facilities available at your college namely Dr. G. D. Pol Foundations Y.M.T. Ayurvedic Medical College and Hospital Institutional area sector-4, Nerul, Navi Mumbai, Kharghar-410210 Maharashtra (Inst. ID AYU0167) to Start 01 New PG courses with 04 Seats in the subject namely :-(i) Kaumarbhritya -04 seats and for Increase Intake capacity in existing 03 PG Courses in the subject namely (i) Kayachikitsa 04 to 08 seats (ii) Shalya Tantra 06 to 08 seats (iii) Stree Roga and Prasuti Tantra 04 to 08 seats from the academic session 2023-24, visitation has been carried out for issuance of Letter of Intent (LoI) on 28.08.2023 & 29.08.2023 through hybrid mode by the visitation team of Medical Assessment and Rating Board (NCISM) and Letter of Intent (LoI) has been issued to your college vide letter of even no. dated 23.09.2023 to start 01 New PG courses with 04 Seats in the subject namely :-(i) Kaumarbhritya -04 seats and for increase intake capacity in existing 03 PG Courses in the subject namely (I) Kayachikitsa 04 to 08 seats (ii) Shalya Tantra 06 to 08 seats (iii) Stree Roga and Prasuti Tantra 04 to 08 seats under section 29 of NCISM Act 2020 from the academic session 2023-24.
- 2. The Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine (NCISM) had carried out an inspection of the college again on 05.10.2023 and 06.10.2023 through Hybrid mode to assess the available facilities of teaching, non-teaching, Hospital staff, practical training and other infrastructure facilities available as a part of annual visitation for issuance of LoP (Letter of Permission) to start 01 new PG courses in the subject namely :-(i) Kaumarbhritya -04 seats and for increase intake capacity in existing 03 PG Courses In the subject namely (i) Kayachikitsa 04 to 08 seats (ii) Shalya Tantra 06 to 08 seats (III) Stree Roga and Prasuti Tantra 04 to 08 seats under section 29 of NCISM Act 2020 from the academic session 2023-24.
- 3. Further, in view of above assessment report and all other related documents were assessed in terms of the enforced regulations namely "the Establishment of New Medical College, Opening of New or Higher Course of Study or Training and Increase of Admission Capacity by a Medical College Regulations, 2019, the "Indian Medicine Central Council (Requirements of Minimum Standard for under-graduate Ayurveda Colleges and attached Hospitals) Regulations, 2016", Indian Medicine Central Council (Requirements of Post-graduate Ayurveda Education) Regulations, 2016, provisions under the NCISM Act, 2020.
- 4. As per the direction of President, Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine (NCISM), the assessment report was placed in the 64th Board Meeting of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine (NCISM) held on 10.10.2023. On careful examination of the assessment report, Board discussed the same and decided to issue LoP (Letter of Permission) for increase intake capacity in existing 03 PG Courses in the subject namely (i) Kayachikitsa from 04 seats to 08 seats (ii) Shalya

Tantra - from 06 seats to 08 seats (iii) Stree Roga and Prasuti Tantra - from 04 seats to 08 seats and for issuance of LOP to start new PG course in the subject namely Kaumarbhritya with 04 seats under section 29 of NCISM Act 2020 from the academic session 2023-24.

- 5. Further, in accordance of the Regulation 6 (2) (i) (i) & 6 (3) (j) (iii) of "Establishment of New Medical College, Opening of New or Higher Course of Study or Training and Increase of Admission Capacity by a Medical College Regulations, 2019 vide letter of an email dated 12.10.2023 a letter was sent to your college to submit the fixed security deposit worth Rs. One Crore [Rs 50 lakh × 01 new PG course = Rs. 50 lakh to start 01 new PG course in the subject namely Kaumarbhritya with 04 seats + Rs. 50 lakh (Rs 5 lakh/seats × 10 seats) for increase intake capacity in existing 03 PG Courses in the subject namely (i) Kayachikitsa -04 seats (from 04 to 08 seats) (ii) Shalya Tantra 06 seats (from 06 to 08 seats) (iii) Stree Roga and Prasuti Tantra 04 seats (from 04 to 08 seats)] in favor of National Commission fund for Indian system of Medicine for the period of three years, in response of the same you have furnished the fixed security deposit in favor of the National Commission fund for Indian system of Medicine of rupees 01 crore through online payment mode vide RTGS number ABHYR52023101305600249 dated 13.10.2023 transferred by Abhyudaya Co-Op Bank LTD., Kharghar, Navi Mumbai (for a period of three years) and informed the same vide an email dated 14.10.2023 enclosing a letter vide ref. no. YMTA/901/2023 dated 14.10.2023.
- 6. Therefore, LoP (Letter of Permission) is issued to Dr. G. D. Pol Foundations Y.M.T. Ayurvedic Medical College and Hospital Institutional area sector-4, Nerul, Navi Mumbai, Kharghar-410210 Maharashtra (Inst. ID AYU0167) to Start 01 New PG course with 04 Seats in the subject namely :-(i) Kaumarbhritya -04 seats and for increase intake capacity in existing 03 PG Courses in the subject namely (i) Kayachikitsa -from 04 to 08 seats (ii) Shalya Tantra -from 06 to 08 seats (iii) Stree Roga and Prasuti Tantra -from 04 to 08 seats under section 29 of NCISM Act, 2020 from the academic session 2023-24 and relevant regulations thereunder, subject to following conditions:
 - I. The college shall submit an undertaking in the form of affidavit duly notarized within one month explaining the details of providing EPF and ESI facilities to the teaching, non-teaching staff of the Colleges/Hospitals and regularly paying the same as per the provisions of Employees' Provident Funds and Miscellaneous Provisions Act, 1952 & ESI Act, 1948 and relevant Rules and Regulations.
 - II. It is further informed that minimum 15% of Post-graduate seats of the permitted intake capacity of 68 seats in 13 PG courses shall be treated as all India quota. The counseling for seats under all India quota shall be conducted by respective counseling authority as designated by Central Government for A.Y. 2023-24 and counseling for the remaining 85% seats or as the case may be, shall be conducted by the concerned Counseling Authority of that State/UT.
